Dear Mr Sauven

Thank you for your letter of 01 April and subsequent messages to my office.

As you know, following a recent search conducted by the French authorities on one of our premises in France, EDF confirms that it has been made aware that a criminal investigation is under way into the facts associated with allegations of "fraudulent intrusion into information systems."

In this context, several employees of Kargus Consultants as well as an EDF employee are under investigation, throughout which they are presumed innocent. The supervisor of the EDF employee, who is in charge of one of the security departments within the Production and Engineering Directorate in France, has been heard as a witness by the judge.

As soon as we became aware of the situation, EDF immediately instigated a civil action for damages as a victim of the company Kargus Consultants, which has in the past worked for us. EDF of course strongly condemns any methods which attempt to fraudulently enter into IT systems.

EDF is in the process of collecting the necessary information to give our fullest cooperation to the legal investigation which will establish any responsibility.
